

Tavistock Canal Wheelchair walk



A wheelchair walk to Shillamill viaduct and back

The route starts in the Meadowlands car Park opposite the Wharf Theatre and takes you firstly beside the River Tavy and then for about a mile and a half next to the Tavistock canal



Set off towards the Meadowlands swimming pool and as you reach it follow the road around to the left and then go right otherwise you will end up in the river. Then follow the riverside path with the River Tavy on your left.



Go past the bandstand and the children's play area and then fork right across the meadow



Using the subway go under the A 386 then follow the school perimeter fence on your left until you reach the school playing field.



On reaching the school playing field fork right off the tarmac path and up to the canal tow path



You can now go for more than a mile and a half to go under Shillamill Viaduct and onto some picnic benches. This is not a circular walk but you do get a different view of the canal on your way back.
